

FOURTH QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS

As December employment numbers are released, it is interesting to note that while California and the Sacramento Region posted job losses and a tick up in respective unemployment rates, Folsom continues to hold strong on employment and posts the lowest unemployment rate in the region - a very healthy 3.2% - followed by Elk Grove at 3.8%, Roseville at 3.8%, Rocklin at 4.1%, Davis at 4.5%, and Rancho Cordova at 5.5%.

AT A GLANCE:

- More than 50% of all annual wages in Folsom are generated by employment in the Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services Sector
- While employment in the Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services Sector has remained largely unchanged in the last five years, wages increased by approximately 10% - or \$33 million
- ► Employment in the Wholesale and Retail Trade Sector has recovered from Great Recession losses and shown strong growth over last three years
- ► Healthcare Sector experienced steady growth over 5-year period, increasing employment by nearly 20% and total wages by 40%
- Accommodation and Food Service Sector has seen largest increase in employment between 2012 and 2016 - as evidenced by all the new restaurant and hotel options in Folsom
- Manufacturing is only sector that saw declines in both the number of establishments and employment over the 5-year period
