

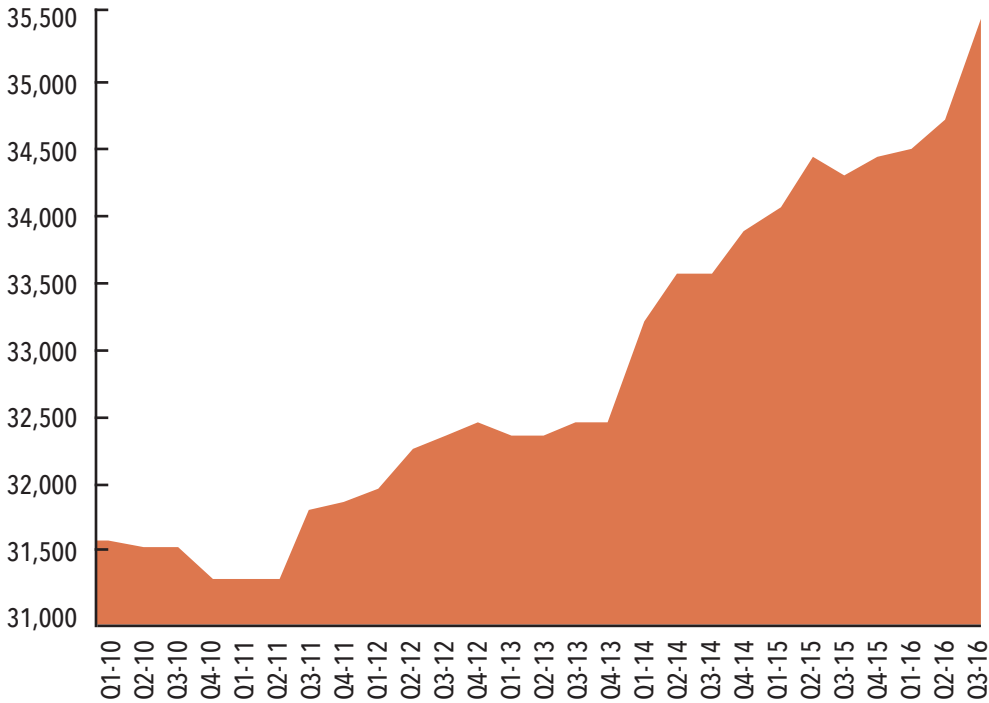


# FOLSOM QUARTERLY ECONOMIC REPORT

### AT A GLANCE:

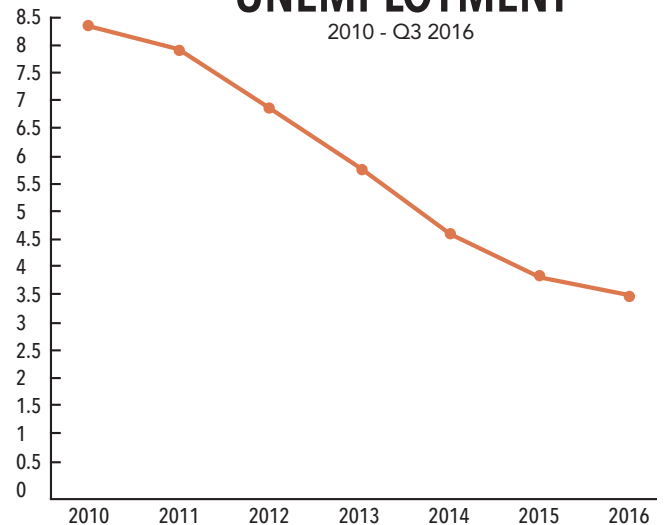
- ▶ Employment has seen steady year-over-year increases in Folsom since 2011, up 4,100 jobs
- ▶ Job growth exceeded population growth in Folsom from 2010 to 2015, with jobs growing by 8.7% and population increasing by 5.8%, indicating a strong base economy
- ▶ Folsom's unemployment rate is the lowest in the Sacramento Region and 14th lowest in California
- ▶ Folsom boasts the highest household median income in the Capital Region, 13th highest in the state
- ▶ The Sacramento Region is home to a regional labor force of more than 1.0 million - larger than the San Francisco Region
- ▶ There are 5,620 companies in Folsom

### THIRD QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS

Folsom's job and population growth continue to lead the region. The professional, scientific, and technical services, finance and insurance, and health care sectors are leading the way in employment growth for Folsom. All of these sectors show increases in jobs and the number of establishments in the last five years. The wonderful shopping and restaurant choices in Folsom are indicative of the strength of the retail, and accommodation and food services sectors. While both employment and number of establishments is still below pre-Great Recession levels, both sectors are coming back strong.
