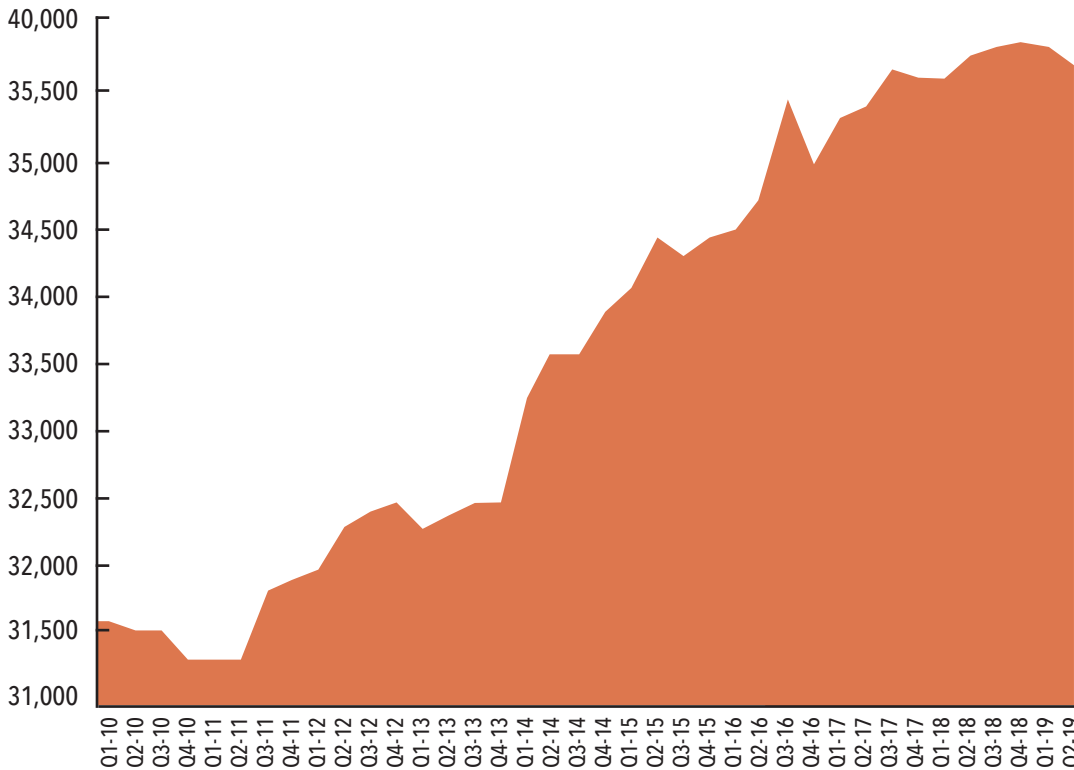

AT A GLANCE:

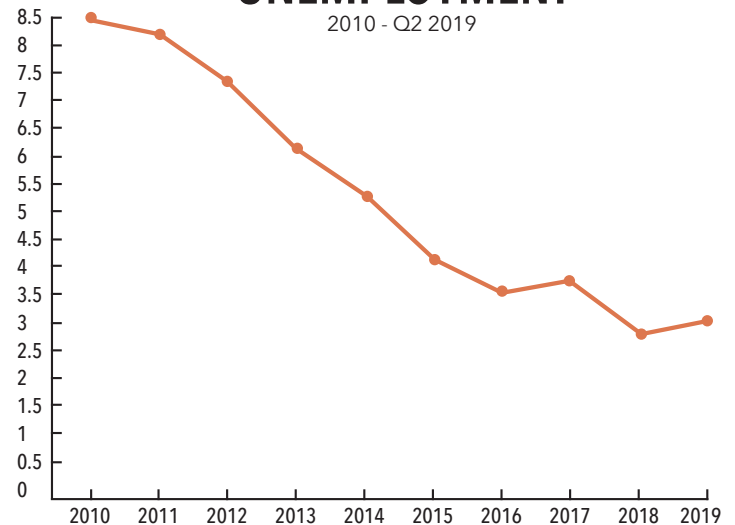
- ▶ Median household income for Folsom is 85% higher than national average
- ▶ More than forty-seven percent of Folsom residents have a Bachelors Degree, as compared to 32% of California residents, and approximately 31% nationwide
- ▶ Folsom continues to boast the highest household median income in the Capital Region, thirteenth highest in California
- ▶ The population in Folsom continues to grow reaching estimated 77,278 residents in 2017
- ▶ Employment in the Sacramento Region increased by 27,500 in 2018 (2.6%), and employment in Folsom increased by 900 in the same period (2.4%)

SECOND QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS

Jobs, population, and the number of establishments in Folsom have all increased in the last year, further solidifying the foundation on which the Folsom economy is based. Jobs in the professional, scientific, and technical services sector and finance and insurance sector led the way in job creation. Folsom employment in December 2018 of 36,800 jobs represents an all-time high for the city - as the unemployment rate for the same period also set a new record at 2.6 percent as a post-Great Recession low. As new development in Folsom continues, opportunities to welcome business to the city, ultimately resulting in the creation of more employment opportunities for Folsom residents, present themselves.
